


Mandatory Safeguarding Training

As part of the Church's ongoing commitment to safeguarding, the Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency has developed its own online learning portal to provide free Level 2 safeguarding training for parish volunteers, in line with the national standards set for all Dioceses within England and Wales.


As part of the DBS renewal process, safeguarding training is now a mandatory requirement for all volunteers in roles involving children and adults who may be at risk. The relevant modules will need to be completed at the time of renewal or before commencing in role if you are a new volunteer.

To access the portal, you will need to sign up for an account and details on how to do this are below:
